Nine new towable models from Kohler offer a full line to serve multiple applications

Kohler, Wis. • April 2009 • Kohler Power Systems will launch a completely new line of towable generators that range from 20 kW to 500 kW. The nine new models will also feature emission-compliant engines and sophisticated enclosures that keep sound levels down to 64 dBA on the smaller models; and to 75 dBA on the larger models.

The nine new REOZT models are offered in the following kW sizes: 20, 40, 60, 100, 125, 150, 200, 275, and 500.

The double-wall fuel tank provides for complete containment of oil, coolant and fuel. Standard features in this rugged towable package also include a battery-disconnect switch, two-stage air filter and water/fuel separator. The KOHLER DEC1000 and DEC4000 controls used on these models provide incredible monitoring functionality in an easy-to-read LED screen, which is visible to the outside via a door-side window. The distribution panel features multiple sockets with individual circuit breakers per receptacle, and selector switch or buss-bar reconnectability with locking access and strain relief. Designed with larger and lockable doors, the new KOHLER towable design provides easy access to the generator when necessary.

“The new heavy-duty design included in all ten new models will serve a variety of applications in the market where mobility and flexibility are crucial in a generator package,” said Ryan Fredrickson, Sr. Product Manager-Industrial, Kohler Power Systems.
